Anyzip is a Windows-based application which can be used to create and view archive files and extract files from them. It has a user-friendly interface and the functions in the system can be operated either using the Anyzip keyboard shortcuts (<http://www.anyzip.com/zip-manual/keyboard.html>) or its menu options (<http://www.anyzip.com/zip-manual/menus.html>).
